Vehicle Insurance:

User agrees to provide full vehicle coverage and to list United Fleet Management as "additional insured and loss payee" on your policy.

Security Deposit:

We will collect a security deposit with your first monthly payment. The amount of your security deposit is equal to your monthly payment. For example, if your payment is \$745, your security deposit is also \$745.

Monthly ACH Payments:

Prorated and billed at the beginning of each month

Maintenance:

Maintenance is the responsibility of the driver or company renting the vehicle. Please refer to the owners manual for the specific items and intervals recommended by the manufacturer.

Vehicle Care:

Normal wear and tear is acceptable. Any damage larger than a credit card will be billed to the primary rental user.

Members will be required to sign a Vehicle Rental Agreement. Eligibility requirements: only Users who are at least 25 years old with a valid driver's license and acceptable driving record (i.e., no DWI/DUI and no more than 3 moving violations in past 3 years).
